

Thanks for your continued support and prayers—and remember, the youth are watching... so stretch before you join them in those dance moves!



Camp Firelight VBS 2025

This year our Church was transformed into Camp Firelight, where children from our church and community gathered to explore what it means to trust God — especially when life feels uncertain. From June 22–26, our church was alive with singing, dancing, storytelling, science, games, and snacks, while our campers learned that God is always with us.





Each day brought a new adventure with Counselor Sam and our lightning bug friend, Lu, leading the way. Our campers learned the Camp Callout, a verse from Psalm 56:3:

"Whenever I'm afraid, I put my trust in You."

Each night the campers learned a new Firelight Focus to remind us of God's presence in every situation — even when we're

afraid. We heard the story of Jacob who

trusted God to go with us, the story of Ruth & Naomi who trusted God to lead the way, the story of young Jesus who trusted God to share wisdom, the story of the disciples and Jesus in the storm who trusted God to give peace, and the story of Philip and the Ethiopian who trusted God to spark joy. This simple yet powerful truth was woven into every song, lesson, and activity to help our children understand that they can turn to God and lean on Him in every situation.



Our mission this year was to support God's Storehouse by collecting jars of peanut butter and boxes of cereal to stock their pantry. We had an awesome outpouring of love and donations that totaled \$103.03, 54 boxes of cereal, and 38 jars of peanut butter as well as 4 cans of chicken. Our children will have the opportunity to deliver these items to God's Storehouse and learn about their mission in July.

A special thank you goes out to every volunteer who made Camp Firelight possible. From decorating and planning to leading crews, preparing snacks, organizing games, guiding music, and praying for each child. Whether you were behind the scenes or leading on the front lines, your service helped plant seeds of faith that will grow for years to come. Thank you for your time, energy, and love reflected in the light of Christ and for answering the call to serve!




READING NOOK
