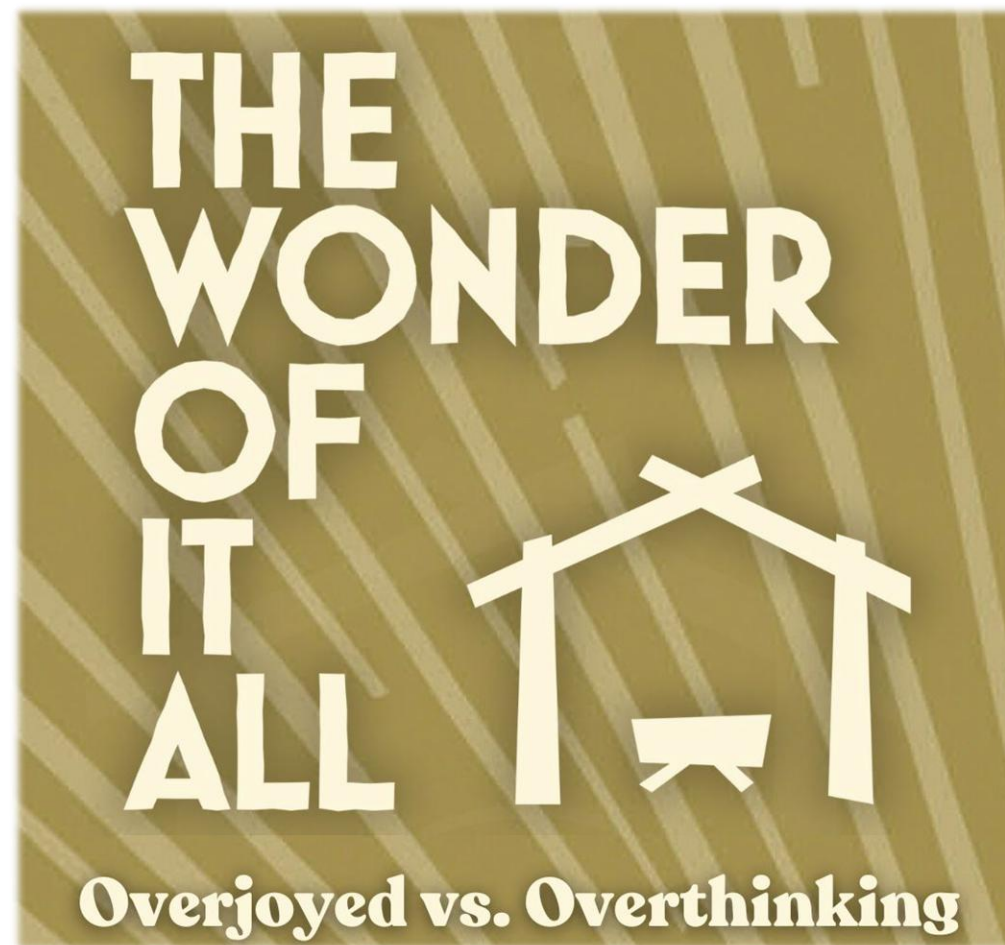
2026 Altar Flowers
